- Long-term unemployed: 2.785M, decrease of 37,000 since last month (unemployed for more than 26 weeks)
- U-6 Unemployment Rate: 11.2% (U-6: total unemployed (U-3) plus discouraged workers (U-4), plus all other marginally attached workers (U-5), plus total employed part time for economic reasons (U-6))
- o There are 4.972M job openings (*November 2014 preliminary*). This equates to 1.7 unemployed persons per job opening, or 3.5 persons using the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

Nonfarm jobs: 140.347M (84.4% private, 15.6% public)

- Monthly change: +252,000 (+240,000 private, +12,000 public)
- Largest industry growth: Professional and business services (+52,000), Construction (+48,000), and Education and health services (+48,000)
- Average monthly job growth (total nonfarm jobs) since December 2013: +246,000
- Compared to December 2007: 1.997M more jobs
 The recession began in December 2007

- Less than a high school diploma: 8.6%
- High school diploma: 5.3%

Initial Claims: 294,000

Initial Claims: The count of notices of unemployment requesting a determination of eligibility and entitlement for Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits. A person can file multiple claims.

- o Some College or Associate Degree: 4.9%
- Bachelor's degree and higher: 2.9%

As educational attainment levels increase, unemployment rates decrease.

- PA U-6 unemployment rate: 12.2% (BLS, 2013Q4 2014Q3)
- o There are 196,100 job openings (*PA JobGateway*). This equates to 1.6 unemployed persons per job opening, or 4.1 persons when considering the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

There are 6,000 online job postings (Conference Board Help Wanted OnLine (HWOL) dataset for November 2014). This equates to 2.6 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 6.6 using an estimated U-6 unemployment rate of 11.2%.
